

How to register students to vote today (Polling Day)

If your students are affected by a clerical error and find they are not on the electoral register, they can be added up until 10pm today when polls close.

The Electoral Commission in Wales told NUS Wales this morning:

- Any person disenfranchised by a “clerical error” caused by the local authority (council) is able to get in touch with the Electoral Registration Office in the local authority and be added to the register by 22:00 on polling day. Once on the register, they will be able to cast their vote up until 22:00 as is the case for everyone else.
- Some local authorities, such as Cardiff Council, are trying to get in touch with individuals who are on record as having been disenfranchised. However, we strongly recommend individuals do not wait and contact local authorities themselves. We are advised these will be processed with urgency.
- A “clerical error” is an error caused by the local authority.
- If the error in registration was caused by a third party, such as a students' university, the Electoral Commission advise that affected individuals make representations to get on the register. NUS Wales advises students' unions to ask institutions who may have made clerical errors to contact the local authority to explain the situation and request for the local authority to place the affected students on the register.
- Every local authority in Wales has the same ability to add individuals to the register up until 22:00, regardless of location. NUS Wales has compiled a list of contact details for the Electoral Registration Office in each local authority.
