Where should I go when I arrive?

Make your way to the NUS Registration desk in the Chancellor Building Atrium. Here is a <u>campus map</u> to help you find your way around!

Will overnight accommodation be provided?

Accommodation is provided for the duration of this course (Tuesday and Wednesday night).

You will receive information about the checking in process at registration. Check in will take place later in the day and storage of luggage is available from registration onwards.

If you require accommodation the night before the event (Monday 22nd July 2019), you will have the option to select this on the registration form. This will be at a charge of £40 + VAT and will be added to the final invoice. Accommodation is at university halls on campus.

What is included in the accommodation?

BEDROOM – single bed, desk, chair and drawers, your own en-suite shower, toilet and sink, high-speed Wi-Fi, plenty of storage for your belongings, with a large built-in wardrobe and bookshelves, bedding, towels, toiletries and hangers.

By rail:

The closest railway station is Bath Spa Train Station which is in Bath City Centre.

It is a 30 – 40-minute walk to the main campus buildings, involving a steep uphill climb. Buses regularly leave from the train station to the University of Bath which takes 15 minutes.

Walking/Cycling:

You can walk or bike from the centre of Bath using:

- North Road
- Bathwick Hill
- Widcombe Hill

These routes involve a steep uphill climb. It will take 30 to 40 minutes to walk to campus.

Walk or bike from the east of Bath to campus using:

- Claverton Down Road
- The Avenue / Claverton Hill (steep uphill climb)

There are several places where you can store your bike securely.

By Bus from Bath Spa Station:

You can take the <u>First Bus Bath Unibus U1 or U1X service</u> from outside Bath Spa Railway Station. This runs every 15 minutes. You can catch this bus from opposite the bus station, which is situated on Dorchester Street. Get off at <u>Arrivals Square</u>, at the University of Bath. It runs from 7am until midnight on weekdays.

Most buses to campus have low floors and wheelchair areas for passengers with disabilities.



By car:

If you are using a satnav, use 'Norwood Avenue, Bath', not 'Quarry Road', to get to the main entrance of the campus and visitor car parks.

Parking:

Yes there is a car park on site. You must display a valid parking permit which will be emailed to you by The Events team ahead of the event. It is important that you print this out with the requested information in order for the permit to be valid.

The best place to park is the **East Car Park (Postcode BA2 7PD)** which is in close proximity to accommodation and conference facilities – to access this car park you should enter campus via Norwood Avenue.
