WHY I AM RUNNING

Over the last years I have seen students dropping out, become homeless, struggling to make ends meet or even getting hospitalised because of the strain that is **student poverty**. Yet, when meeting Student Presidents earlier this year, Education Minister Richard Lochhead, had the cheek to call our Student Support System 'generous'.

What does it tell us when politicians, who themselves were given grants during their study and who proceed over a society where the richest 10% have over 900 times more wealth than the poorest 10%, find it hard to come to recognise our struggles? What does it tell us when our institutions are given the option to either cut courses drastically or put a price tag on our education?

The answer is clear: if we want to fight for the eradication of poverty, campaign for keeping our education free from price tags, and widen our education in the face of cuts, our message should be clear: no more compromises.
