

The role of a delegate

As a NUS Scotland liberation conference delegate you have three main roles which include; **voting on policy, voting in elections, voting on reports.**

Policy – setting the direction of NUS Scotland liberation campaigns

You will discuss and vote on motions which will become policy of each NUS Scotland liberation campaign when passed. The policy will inform the organisation about what you, its student members, think about key issues.

Elections – choosing the leadership of NUS Scotland liberation campaigns

You will be able to choose the leadership of NUS Scotland liberation campaigns for the coming year. The positions you will be voting on are the Women's/LGBT+/Black Students'/Disabled Students'/Trans representatives. More information can be found in the Election Rules document.

Reports – reviewing the work of NUS Scotland liberation campaigns

You will be reviewing the work of the NUS Scotland liberation campaigns. During the report session you will receive an overview of the work and have the opportunity to hold to account the officers and committees responsible by asking them questions and voting on whether to approve it.
