

## **Notice of NUS Scotland Trans Conference 2019**

NUS Scotland Trans Conference will be held on **Wednesday 3 April 2019** at the Norton Park Conference Centre, Albion Road, Edinburgh EH7 5QY.

Each Constituent Member (CM) is entitled to send the same number of delegates as for NUS Scotland

Conference, please see the Delegate Entitlement document for full details.

All persons attending NUS Scotland Trans Conference in whatever capacity shall define under the Trans umbrella (including but not limited to the following identities: agender, androgyne, gender-fluid, genderqueer, transgender, transsexual, transvestite, neutrois, non-binary) and those who are questioning their gender identity.

There shall be no limit on the number of observers that a Constituent Member may send. Observers will have full speaking rights but no voting rights.

#### **Motions and amendments**

Each CM may submit up to 3 motions. Motions must be submitted via the online motion submission form.

Following the circulation of motions, each CM may submit a maximum of 3 amendments. The maximum length of a motion is 300 words and amendments are limited to 200 words. Any which exceed these limits will be automatically ruled out of order.

A motion (and amendment) must contain text – i.e. a subject heading is not sufficient.

#### Registration

Registration will be open shortly and the deadline is **Monday 25 March 2019**.

# Registration constitutes a liability to pay the appropriate fees unless cancelled by the closing date.

Registration fees payable for all delegates and observers will be **£17.50 plus VAT** or **£25 plus VAT** if attending LGBT+ Conference which is being held on the same day.
