NUS UK manifesto for the European Parliamentary elections

The last few years have seen the UK divided. Brexit has created political paralysis and too often a less tolerant and more fearful society. Meanwhile, students and young people have been ignored by too many politicians, even though <u>it's your future</u> that will be decided in the next few months.

Why do the European Parliamentary elections matter to you?

The European Parliamentary elections (EPe's), held on 23 May 2019, are an opportunity:

- for students and young people to have their voices heard
- > to tell our leaders what we want our relationship with our closest neighbours to be
- > to reject the narrow-minded, insular attitude that threatens to make the UK the poorer, both socially and financially.

What do we want you to do, and how can you do it?

We want you to **VOTE for candidates** standing in these elections **who commit to eight essential policies**; and we encourage all students and young people to consider parties and candidates who endorse them.

The EIGHT essential policies we believe politicians must endorse

- 1. **Hold a People's Vote** on any Brexit deal agreed by the UK.
- 2. **Guarantee EU funding,** post-Brexit, which has previously supported access to further education and apprenticeships.
- 3. **Guarantee EU funding,** post-Brexit, which has previously supported research in higher education.
- 4. **Guarantee protections** for EU national apprentices post-Brexit.
- 5. **Protect inward and outward student mobility** post-Brexit, including participation in fully-funded Erasmus+ or any successor schemes and cross-border study on the island of Ireland.
- 6. **Create a fair immigration system** for all migrants including international students, with post-study work visas lasting at least two years.
- 7. **Ensure no hard border** on the island of Ireland and protect peace and the Good Friday agreement.
- 8. **Ensure continued recognition of UK and EU qualifications** post-Brexit.
