What has NUS Scotland won for you?

- ✓ NUS Scotland won an extra £21 million for student cost-of-living support, delivering better bursary support, and a bursary of £8,100 for care-experienced students.
- ✓ After NUS Scotland lobbying, your university must have mental health support in place for students. And from next academic year, QMU will benefit from new counselling provision as part of a £20 million Scottish Government investment in new counsellors.
- ✓ We're working with students' associations across Scotland to scrap graduation charges - and we want QMU to be next!
- Thanks to NUS Scotland, from 2021 students will pay back their student loan once earning £25,000 and above - up from £18.330 now.
- ✓ NUS Scotland supported the Royal College of Nursing to lobby the government to increase the Scottish nursing and midwifery bursary to £10,000 from 2020/21.
- Fighting Brexit and campaigning to protect opportunities for students in Scotland and across the EU.
- NUS Scotland successfully lobbied for tuition fees to be scrapped.
